## **Nature of support 2016-2017 – funding to be used to support all eligible pupils by:**

Staff costs –

Speech and language Department staff costs, Speech & Language Therapist, Two Assistant Speech and Language Therapists and 4 Speech and Language Assistants.

Pastoral Support Co-ordinator aimed at improving outcomes of our most disadvantaged pupils.

Support for pupils to attend residential visits (promoting emotional resilience).

## Measuring the impact of PPG spending

### *Speech and language*

The speech and language department has grown such that extra pupils can be seen. This frees the senior therapist to focus on the pupils with more severe autism. The department also employs 4 part-time speech and language assistants.

Academic progress is measured using in-house assessment methods and are moderated externally to ensure rigour.

### *The Therapeutic Team*

Our team will provide individual support to our pupils. The impact will be measured by teacher / pupil and parental views. Pupils will also benefit from Play and Art Therapy.

Physiotherapy will be provided, five pupils on a daily basis.

### *Residential visits*

Residential visits will enable our students to experience real life learning and challenging opportunities, in many instances the first time away from home. This will also provide respite for families.

ICT Innovation – the budget will support the purchase of ipads and laptops.

In addition to the above, the school consults with staff for any innovative ideas that could be trialled.

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
