Our school theme for the year is pushing yourself that little bit further, being 10% braver (or a little bit braver) for growth. This has been introduced to both staff and students, with all being encouraged to push themselves towards their own personal excellence. This may be academic, social or emotional and can cover a wide spectrum.

Examples include an improved accreditation offer for our Key Stage 4 children, staff asking to learn to drive the minibus, our new prefect system which is being brought in for year 6 children – the opportunities are endless! I look forward to sharing examples of how students and staff have reached their 10% over the year.

Building Improvements

As discussed at the end of last year, our CCTV network was improved over the Summer to include cameras in all classroom areas as well as enhancing the existing network in corridors and playgrounds. We hope that the CCTV will never have to be used but it is reassuring to have it in place for the safety of students and staff.





Respite 'The Bungalow' We were delighted to accept the keys to our new respite house over the Summer. For now, this will be used as our Key Stage 5 Autism Hub during the day whilst the process of opening it as a Respite House is explored. For now, Archie, Tom and David are keeping busy as they practice their life-skills as part of their curriculum offer.

Parent Forum

I will be holding a parent forum once a half term at 5pm in the hall. This is an opportunity to hear about school and curriculum improvements. There is no need to book, just turn up on the day. The forum will last approximately half an hour. Unfortunately, there will be no staff to supervise children so we would encourage children not coming to this session.

Snack

School will no longer be providing a morning snack (except for children in the Autism bases) as the costs of this were becoming too high. If children wish to have a snack at breaktime, they will need to bring this in with them. A reminder that we are a <u>nut and soya free</u> school and where possible, we are a Healthy School, and we would encourage snack choices to reflect this.

Free fruit will continue to be provided for our youngest children.

Attendance

A polite reminder that children are expected in school every day unless very unwell. We are fortunate enough to have a Care Coordinator on site who can keep an eye on children who have a slight cold, are complaining of tummy ache (but who haven't been sick or had diarrhoea) or who may be a little tired. We will be introducing attendance meetings this term to discuss how we can work in partnership to improve attendance for some of our children if we feel it is becoming a problem. Under the new guidance from the Department for Education, 'persistently absent' is classed as any attendance less than 90%, this is 20 school days across the year.
